





ADVANCED LEARNER LOANS

Available through Stoke on Trent College

Loans are available to meet the tuition costs of selected Level 3 to Level 6 qualifications.

Loans are available to individuals who are:

- Aged 19 or over at the start of their course
- Resident in the UK (minimum 3 years)
- Have not previously had a loan to do the same level and type of qualification

Loans will not be means tested, be subject to credit checks or employment status. You won't have to pay anything back until you are earning over £25,000* per year and the loan will be written off after 40 years. If the loan is for an Access to Higher Education programme and you successfully go on to complete a Higher Education course, you won't have to pay back your Advanced Learner Loan.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT - ADULT BURSARY
