

T LEVELS TAKE YOUR FUTURE TO THE NEXT Level with a t level qualification

DEVELOP THE SKILLS. KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE TO MAKE YOU CAREER-READY.

T Levels are an alternative to A Levels and Apprenticeships. Equivalent to 3 A Levels, a T Level focuses on technical skills in a discrete technical subject.

Each T Level includes an in-depth industry placement that lasts at least 45 days. You will gain valuable experience in the workplace to help boost your CV, giving you a competitive advantage when it comes to finding a job and enabling you to succeed in your chosen vocation or progress to university.

You should be aged 16-18 and will need a minimum of five GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including Maths and English. Some of our T Levels have alternative entry requirements – visit the course pages in this prospectus for more information. The College offers a Foundation T Level programme, so if you don't get the grades for entry on to a T Level we can work with you for a year to give you the skills and qualifications you need to progress onto a full T Level programme the following year.

T Levels are designed to enable you to progress to university, into employment, to a degree-level Apprenticeship or further higher-level study at college.

WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

An Apprenticeship gives you hands-on experience, a salary and the opportunity to train while you work. Apprenticeships are equivalent to a full-time academic gualification and there are a wide range of areas you can complete an Apprenticeship in. See our subject pages 140-143 for details.

WHO CAN APPLY?

An Apprenticeship is a paid work opportunity for people aged over 16 in England who:

- are early in their career
- are looking to upskill or change their current job role
- are not in full time education

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF AN APPRENTICESHIP?

- 20% of your time is set aside for learning

Once the employer is all set up, we will then contact you to discuss the Apprenticeship and make sure you're eligible. You'll need to provide additional personal information to us at this stage and will need to complete initial assessments in Maths and English.




