Jessica has studied over 20 Distance Learning courses with Stoke on Trent College to enhance her knowledge in the Health & Social Care sector.





An Access to Higher Education (HE) Diploma is your stepping stone to university and a rewarding career. This flexible, oneyear course is designed for adults and will equip you with essential skills and knowledge to progress to a Degree - no prior qualifications needed, just an ambition to succeed!

Studying an Access to Higher Education (HE) qualification is a great option for adults who want to go to university to progress to a range of careers, but don't have traditional qualifications such as A Levels. It offers academic subject knowledge alongside the development of specialist study skills.

If you are aged 19-23 and this is your first full Level 3 qualification then you will be eligible for FREE tuition and you won't need to pay any fees.

If you aren't eligible for FREE tuition then an Advanced Learner Loan is available to pay your fees upfront, and if you successfully complete a Degree qualification following your Access course, the loan is written off!





The UK Government offers funding options for many adults and adult learning courses, however residency criteria can apply. If you have not been ordinarily resident in the UK for 3 years or more, contact Admissions for more information.

DO I HAVE TO PAY?

Your course is FREE if you are:

- Studying a Level 2 Distance Learning course and live in England (subject to a postcode check)
- Studying English/Maths (if you don't have GCSE grade 4/C or above)
- Aged 19-23 and studying an eligible first full Level 2 or Level 3
- Aged 19+ and earn below £25,000 annual gross salary (whether unemployed, employed or self-employed) studying selected courses (regardless of prior qualifications).

If you believe you are entitled to FREE tuition, you will need to bring evidence with you when you enrol where appropriate, such as an entitlement letter or award notice.



ADVANCED LEARNER LOANS

Available from Student Finance England

Loans are available to meet the tuition costs of selected Level 3 to Level 6 qualifications.

Loans are available to individuals who are:

- Aged 19 or over at the start of their course
- Resident in the UK (minimum 3 years)
- Have not previously had a loan to do the same level and type of qualification

Loans will not be means tested, be subject to credit checks or employment status. You won't have to pay anything back until you are earning over £25,000* per year and the loan will be written off after 40 years. If the loan is for an Access to Higher Education programme and you successfully go on to complete a Higher Education course, you won't have to pay back your Advanced Learner Loan.

You should be aged 19 or over on 31st August 2025.
